Key Facts and Update on the Work of the Expert Group Digitalisation and AI

- Main objectives are:
 - To **foster dialogue on the potential of digitalisation and Artificial Intelligence (AI)** in (higher) education with specific regard to the four priorities of the ASEM Education Process as well as the Sustainable Development Goals through peer-learning activities
 - Collaboration and connectivity should be strengthened by identifying, sharing and promoting good practices of digitally enhanced cooperation
- The Expert Group has been established in 2019 and consists of 53 members
- The meetings of the current working period follow a **peer-learning approach** with topics on e.g.:
 - Micro-credentials
 - Digitally enhanced learning and teaching
 - Digital Transformation and Gender Imbalance in AI
