

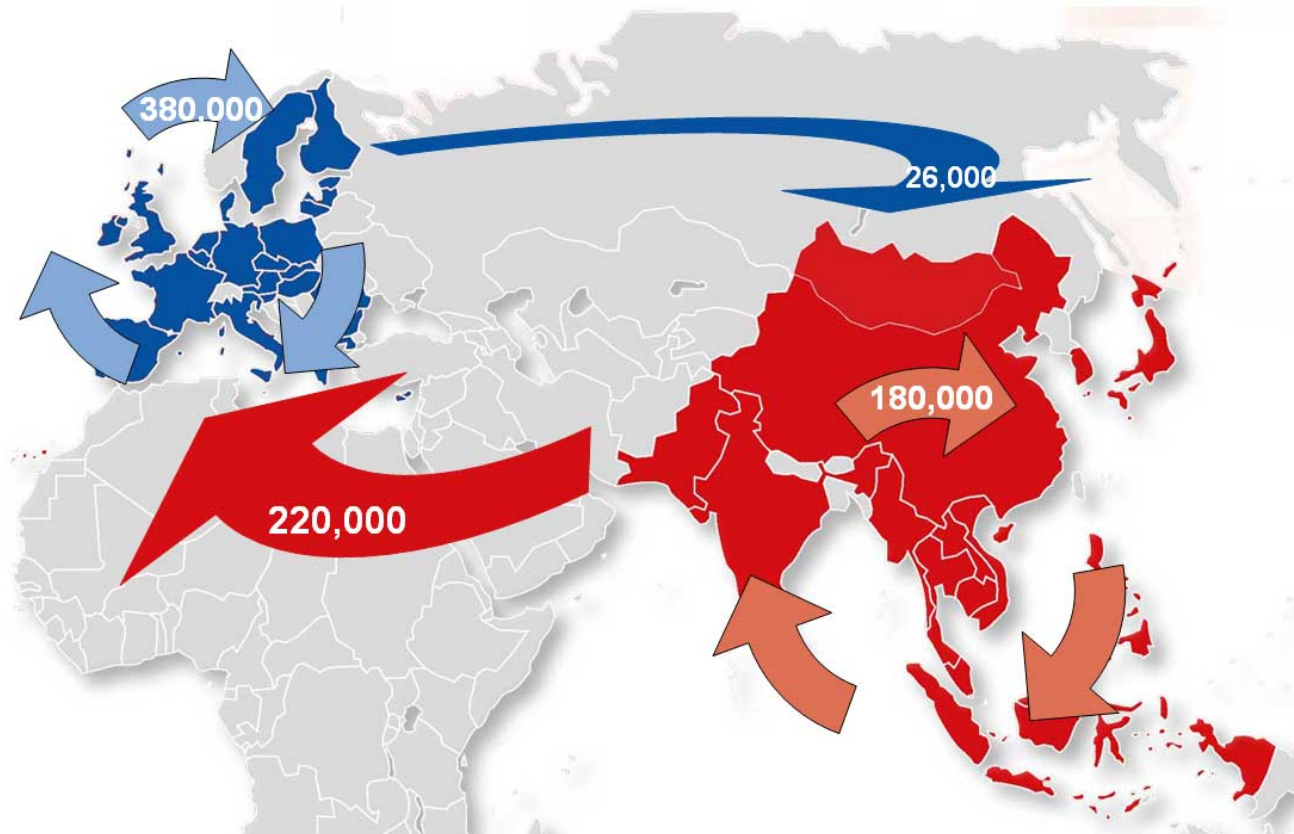

  - (2) At institutional level (university, company)

- Lack of entrepreneurial thinking in university
  - Difficulties in making contact with university
  - No staff and administrative capacities in companies / SMEs
  - Fewer internships in times of crisis
  - Funding
  - Legal and administrative barriers (visa, work permit, insurance)
