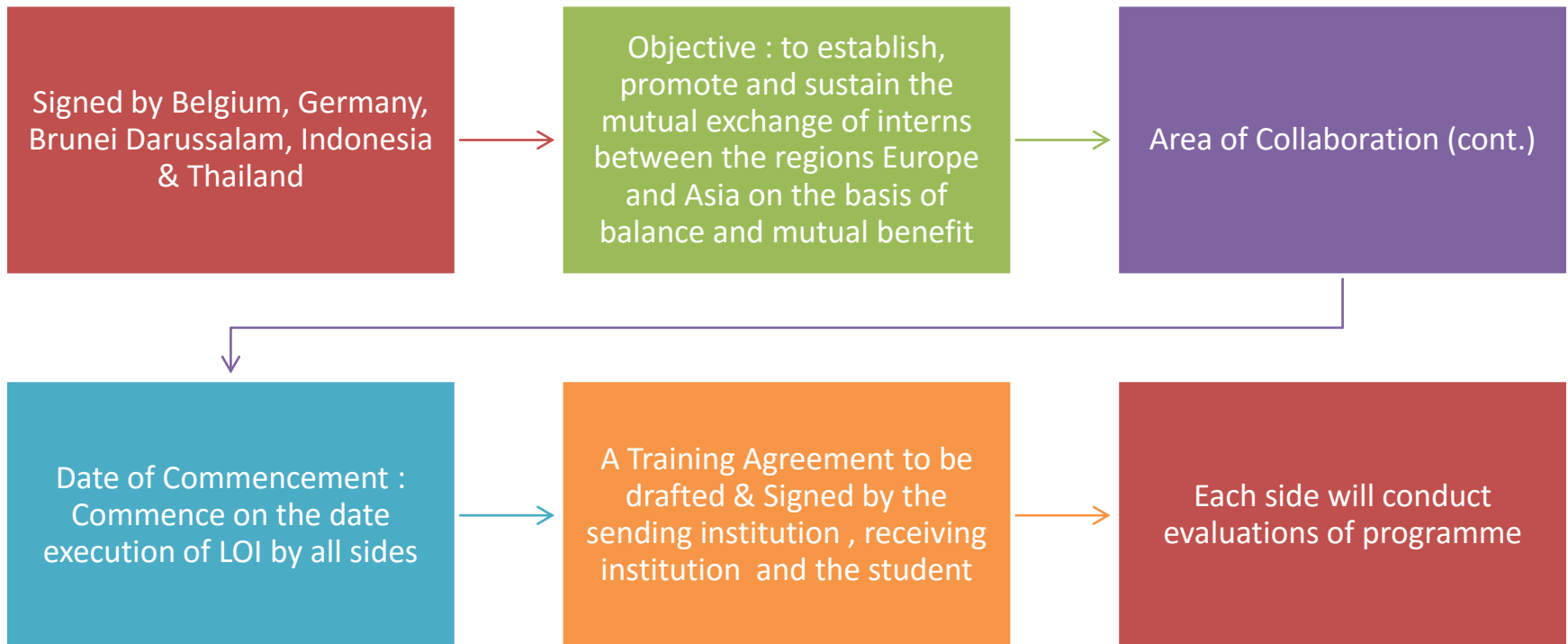

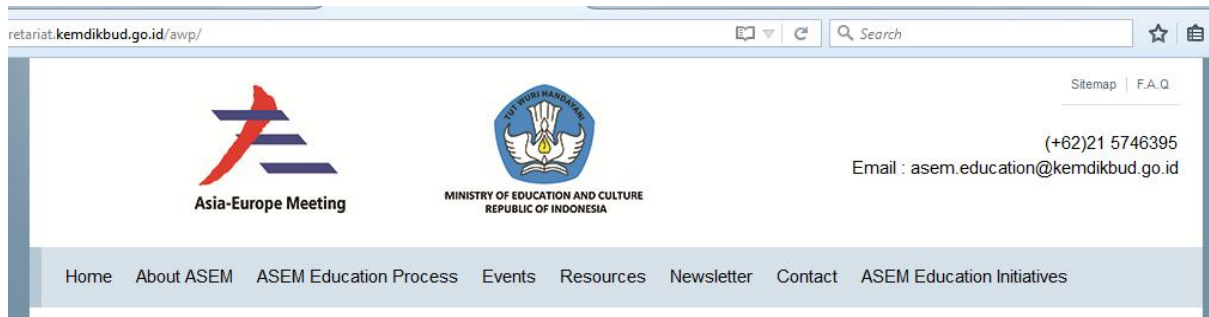

ASEM Work Placement Programme

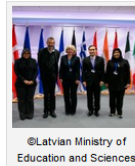
BACKGROUND

The Third Asia-Europe Meeting of Ministers for Education (ASEMME3) held in Copenhagen, Denmark on 9 and May 2011 considered that a work placement programme would provide opportunities for students to gain international work experience and discover the world work in a different region and culture. The Ministers "Considered the establishment of an ASEM placement programme in terms of setting up a pilot scheme for higher education-business mobility of qualified students between Asia and Europe (partly funded by public resources and industry)". (No.8 ASEMME3 Conclusions by the Chair). The ASEM Education Secretariat Bonn presented the outline of the programme in the Third University-Business Forum which was held in Kuala Lumpur from 10-11 November 2012.



In the ASEMME4 held in Kuala Lumpur in May 2013, the Ministers underlined that the work placement programme would enhance graduate employability and endorsed the launch of an initiative. They also welcomed the expressions of Belgium (Flemish Community) and Thailand to take part in the pilot phase of the programme in Bangkok, Thailand.

ASEMME5 AND SIGNING OF A LETTER OF INTENT



The letter of Intent was signed by Belgium, Brunei Darussalam, Germany, Indonesia and Thailand during the Second Senior Officials Meeting of ASEMME5 on 26 April 2015. The main of the letter is to ensure the members keep contributing to the implementation of the ASEM Work Placement Pilot Programme which will lead to balanced mobility of students between both regions.
