## REGION: Asia and Pacific

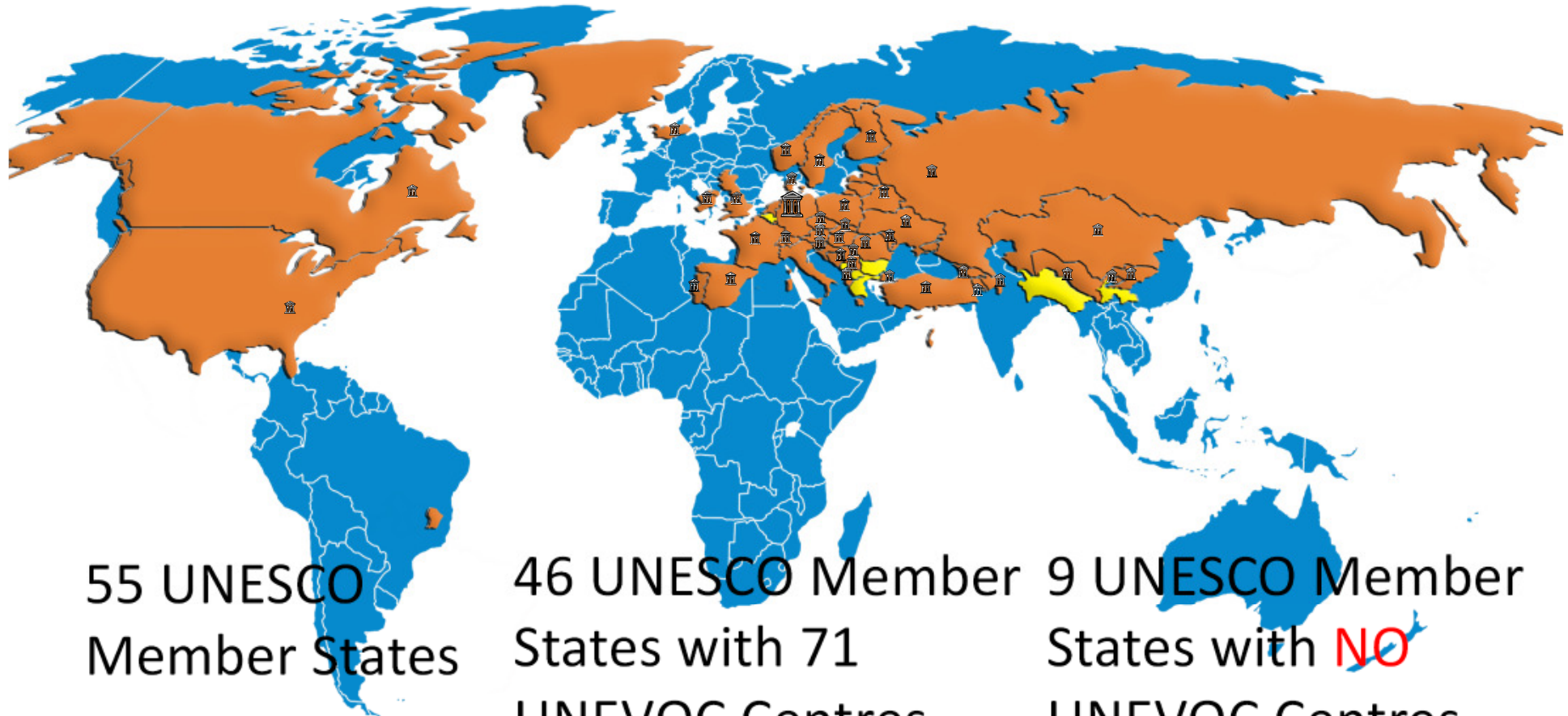


# Basic Situation of UNEVOC Centres in UNESCO Member States in Asia and the Pacific.
