




More contributors to join ASEM-DUO Fellowship Programme




Current status of education at ASEM

ASEM-MOOC



At the 6th ASEM Education Ministers' Meeting, "ASEM-MOOC Initiative" was adopted to promote educational development and cooperation between Asia and Europe

Currently, 14 countries(8 Asian + 6 European) participate and share MOOC content and best practices
