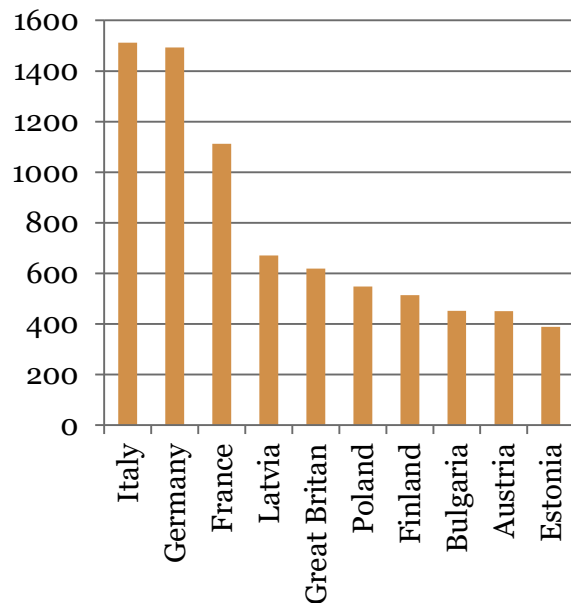

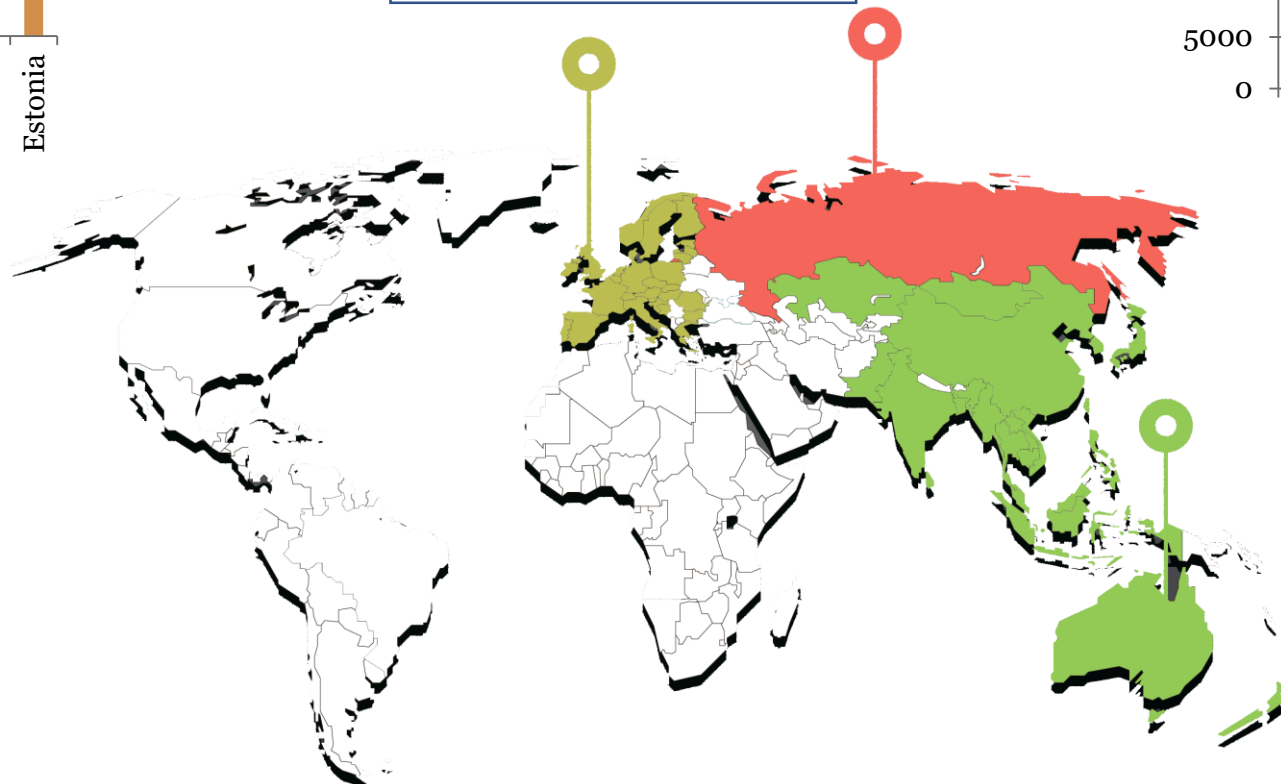
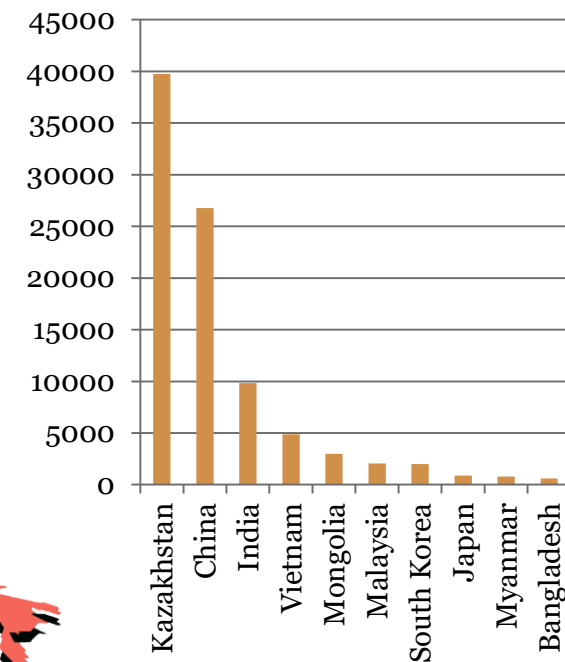

- **20% of international students granted Russian Government Fellowship on the basis of “Olympiad” contest results**

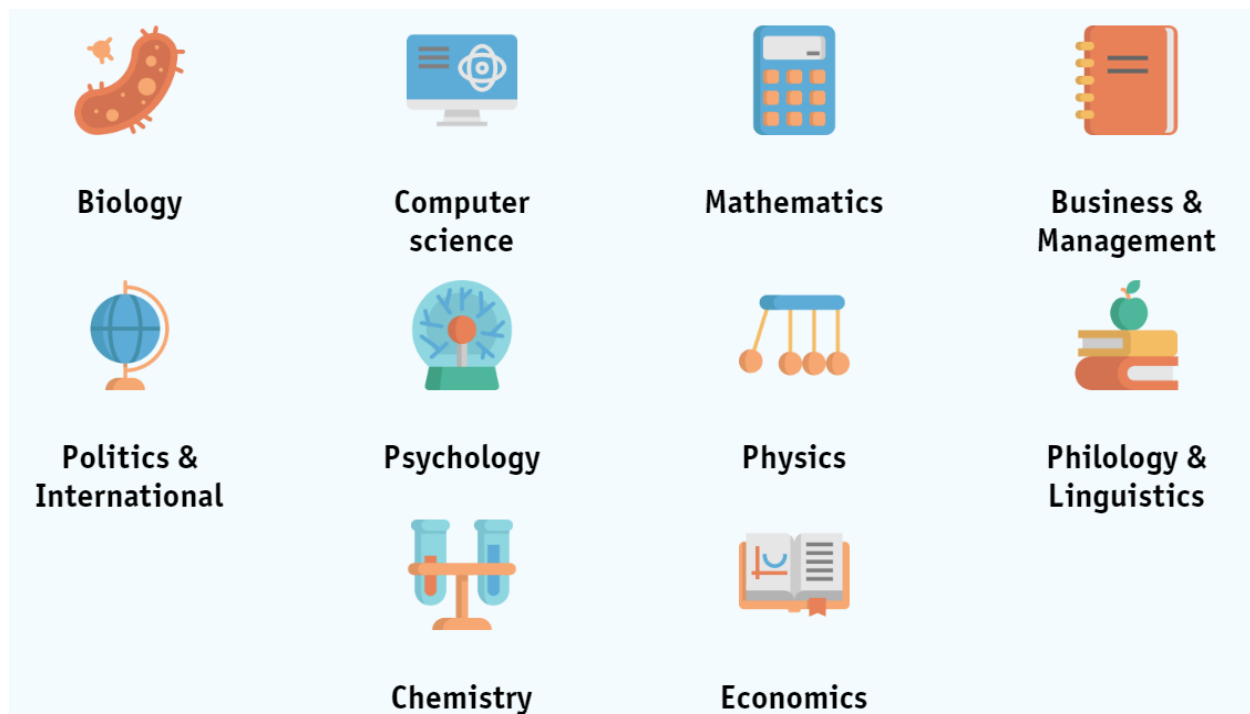

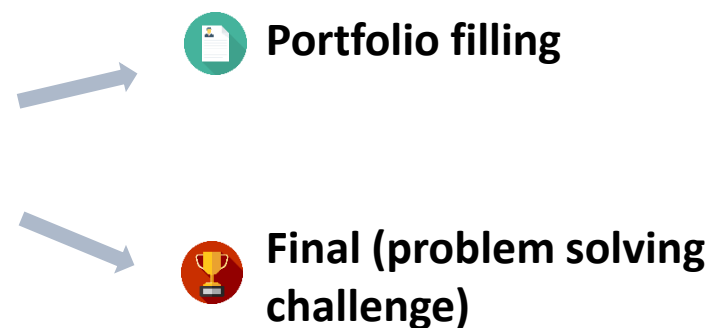

Russian system of provision access to tertiary education for people with disabilities

(currently in Russian HEIs there are 24,300 students with disabilities, less than 1% of the total number)

- Based on Law
- Network of resource centres (21) interconnected with HEIs (369) covering the whole territory of the country
- Internet portal providing also on-line courses and other forms of support
- Trainings for universities' staff and student volunteers to provide necessary assistance
- Interaction with employers
