Jun, 2009 ASEAN-ROK Commemorative Summit (Korea)

Dr. Surin Pitsuwan (Secretary-General of ASEAN)

Initiated the idea of establishing an "ASEAN-ROK Cyber University" to promote cooperation in education and build academic human network.

Nov, 2009 4th ASEAN Senior Officials Meeting on Education (SOM-ED)

- Korea's proposal for establishing the ASEAN Cyber University
- Agreement of participation from all 10 ASEAN member states

Jan, 2012 Officially Launched ACU Project

Proposed by the Ministry of Education in Korea.

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July, 2013 Reserved Final Decision of ACU Establishment
At SOM-ED, ASEAN and ROK agreed on to reserve the decision until 2020.

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January, 2016 Korea Education and Research Information Service(KERIS) was designated as a new Secretariat in the 2 nd phase of the ACU Project



- Period: 2 weeks










