






Most outbound Thai students will be exchange students



Development of academic collaboration agreements







Selecting partner universities

- Consider academic calendar and schedule
- Consider living costs (for outbound students)
- Consider language of instruction
- Consider number and variety of courses offered for exchange students



4 deterrents for MUIC students

- Academic calendar
- Availability of classes and diversity of curriculum
- Language of instruction for classes and in daily life
- Cost of living



3 incentives for European students

- MUIC academic calendar is flexible
- All classes are in English
- Thailand is inexpensive



Case study of European university partners with balanced student mobility with MUIC

Student exchange models that worked for MUIC



Model 1: Business School, University of Mannheim, Germany

- Changed the schedule to finish before January
- Classes offered in English are varied
- Scholarships were offered to the first group of MUIC students



Model 2: University of Applied Sciences – Heilbronn, Germany

- Honor the 2/2 exchange agreement
- Accept additional students as fee paying students



Model 3: ESC Bretagne Brest Business School, France

- Flexibility of student exchange program
- Inbound and outbound can join in the undergraduate and graduate levels



Model 4: University of Nice-Sophia Antipolis, France

- Inbound students study in BBA program
- Outbound students study in French language programs



- Successful study abroad program is a long term commitment
- Successful study abroad programs benefit the college, the university and European – Thai Educational exchange
