- RN Coordinator + Joint-Coordinator (Asia) and Joint-Coordinator (Europe)
- RNs have equitable gender and geographical spread
- RNs own research agenda, but build synergies across all RNs
- RNs engage with wider research community and stakeholders
- ASEM LLL Hub outputs Open Source

- Began development of book on Learning Cities (May 2021)
- Co-hosted with COLLO a pre-conference workshop on Learning Cities (June 2021)










- Develop and expand networks to include members from all 51 ASEM countries
