# ESN Goes Global



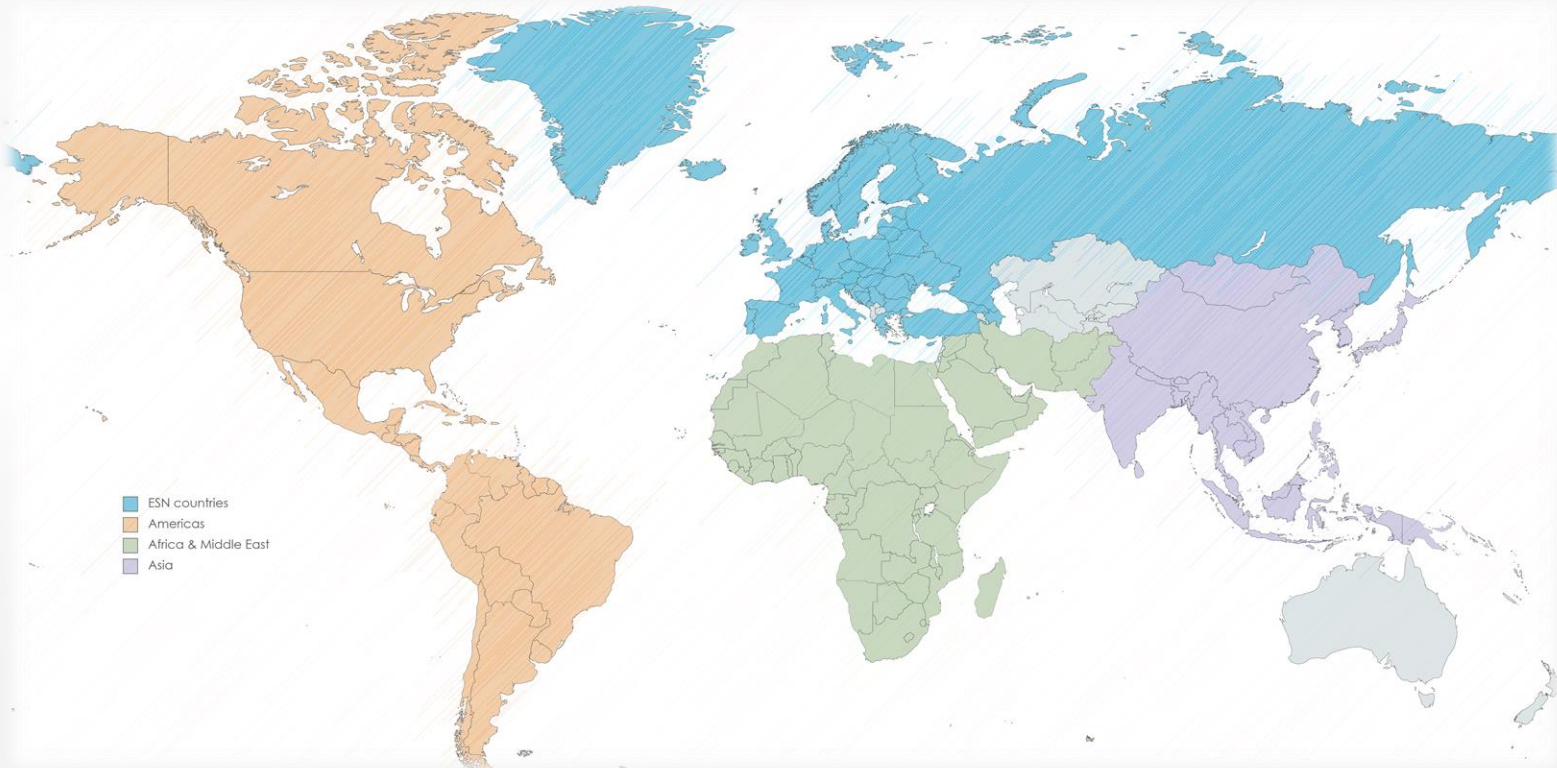
Around 25% of the international students we are in touch with come from countries outside of the European Union.

We believe that there is need for an Asian counterpart to ESN.

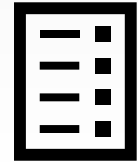
- I. There are many organizations working for students, youth, and internationalisation in Asia. However, none is as universal as ESN is in Europe.
- II. An umbrella organization (and therefore a common point of contact) would streamline efforts for improving connectivity with other regions.
- III. ESN can help raise the quality of support for international students coming from and going to Asia and share experience in areas such as inclusion.
