



What is the Stocktaking Report?

- 1. It is intended to give an **overview of activities and projects** which enhance cooperation and take the ASEM Education Process forward.
- 2. It is the main instrument for monitoring the implementation of the ASEM Education Strategy and progress of activities in line with the Action Plan 2030. Senior Officials and stakeholders are expected to actively contribute to this report by providing updates on their on-going activities to the AES.
- 3. The Stocktaking Report 2024 will lay out the outcomes and progress of the ASEM Education Process (AEP) between the two Ministerial Meetings (ASEMME8 and ASEMME9) and will present new and future activities for the next biennial.






Who drafts the Stocktaking Report?

- **1.** The ASEM Education Secretariat (AES) drafts the Stocktaking Report, based on:
 - The input from ASEM countries and stakeholders on the state of play of their activities, especially the ones mentioned in previous Chair's Conclusions and Stocktaking Report;
 - Expert Groups' activities
 - Commitments and priorities for the next ASEMME;
 - ✓ The results of the ISOM 2022 and SOM 2023;
 - ✓ The recommendations and outcomes of the ASEM Expert Groups, seminars and/or conferences.
- **2.** The ASEMME9 host (Malta) and the Standing Working Group (SWG) are consulted regularly
- **3.** The ASEM countries and stakeholders revise and contribute to this Report








Chair's Conclusions from Bangkok to Valletta
