Background

- **ASEM Workshop** on 23-24 September 2021: towards agile, multi-modal and value-based learning mobility.
- 8th ASEM Education Ministers Meeting (**ASEMME8**) endorses proposal for SEA-Europe mobility programme as part of 2030 ASEM Education Action Plan.
- The Asia-Europe Foundation (**ASEF**) Regional Conference on Higher Education (**ARC9**) publishes report on **Asia-Europe Higher Education Mapping: Working Towards the SDGs**.



- Highlighting the need of translating global goals into local action
- The role of governments to lead efforts towards the SDGs.
- Contributions of inter-regional partnerships and collective intelligence

The SEA-Europe Mobility Programme through the ASEM Framework

Objectives

Maximise the contribution of higher education to Sustainable Development by:

1. **Exploring new innovative model(s)** of learning mobility: agile, future-oriented, value-based for SD
2. **Providing a collective learning space** to encourage multi-level partnerships and the sharing of knowledge and sustainable practices between regions
3. **Empowering diverse learners** with skills and competencies to become active global citizens.

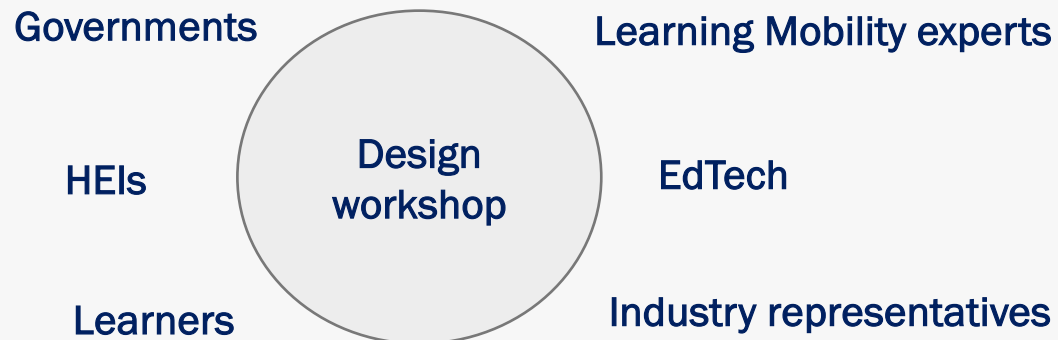

2 Phases:

1. Design (2023-2024)
2. Launch and Review (2024-2025)

Launch and Review

Expected Outcomes:

1. **Launch of Programme:** learners participate in the co-designed inter-regional learning mobility
2. **Review Workshop:** all stakeholders reflect on the programme for improvements on the next cycles
3. **Post Workshop activity:** results and recommendations are shared with ASEM Partners and Stakeholders
